# 5 FROM THE HANGAR

#### 5.1 FROM SHARAD

Here is my Hangar 9 330SC. It is a 65-inch wingspan 3D flyer. Running a Power470KV motor and 4500mah 6s batteries and Savox/MKS servos.

It's a great flyer and really large for a single 6s battery. It is really unfortunate HorizonHobby discontinued this plane. One cannot find a plane this big that runs on a single 6s.

It can do both low-to-the-ground 3D and extreme aerobatics (XA) flying really well.



#### 5.2 FROM STEPHEN FAUST

This is a Hangar 9 Valiant setup on the Hangar 9 cub floats. Great flying airplane even with the addition of the heavy floats. It has a DLE-35RA for power, and flaps. Very stable nice flying airplane, but also very aerobatic for a high wing airplane. Takeoff and landing can be accomplished within a few fuselage lengths with the use of flaps and a slight high alpha landing profile. On floats, it's still has enough power to almost hold a hover. The floats are a perfect match and have pre-installed blind nuts in the Valiant for a bolt on installation. I didn't need to adjust much at all, and it flew very well on the maiden flight.
