Attended: 14 (via Zoom)

- 1. Saket S: **6 members registered** [to date] for 2021
 - a. Jeff W/Saket will be sending a reminder email to renew membership. From today, the 2020 membership is not valid and it is advised not to fly until it is renewed.
- 2. Everyone: We should look into guidelines in displaying the pilot's information on the aircraft.
 - a. How to resolve the issue: Jeff will review the guidelines provided by AMA/FAA.
- 3. Jeff W: **Card holder and frequency pin** topic was brought in earlier meeting. We will keep using the membership card and everyone should display it when flying.
 - a. <u>How to resolve the issue</u>: Jeff purchased card holders with a marker that he will leave in the gazebo. People can print their membership card and insert it in the card holder.
- 4. John P: The **membership card** needs to be worn on the pilot (hat, shirt, etc) so that they are identifiable.
 - a. Everyone agreed that the membership card needs to be visible.
 - b. Pilots using FM transmitters should display their frequency pin and should be proactive in communicating with fellow pilots.
- 5. Jeff W: The **club-owned** airplane is ready and tested it. He will share the key information so that it is accessible to the trainers.
- 6. **Election**: None of the current officers were challenged.
 - a. New change is Paul as President and Mel as VP.
- 7. Show and Tell:
