

4.1 AIRTAG LOCATION TRACKER — BY MARK KNIGHT

I recently bought an Apple AirTag despite not being able to think of a useful application for it at the time. My purchase was driven more by a desire to play with a gadget than anything else. I will probably jinx myself now, but I don't misplace things that would be good to use an AirTag to find, so finding a good application was a real challenge. It is nice to want new technology to play with and justify buying it by tying it to an often dubious but plausible use case.

Failing to find one for the AirTag, I went and bought one anyway. And then came MCRCF. © I have ordered an AirTag holder designed for a dog collar that I plan to attach to the Velcro battery strap, but until then, there is a temporary patch to stick it to the underside of the canopy. The AirTag weighs 0.39 oz.





My original plausible use was to put it in my checked luggage, so I could know when it is coming onto the luggage retrieval system or which airport it is at, or where to find it in lost luggage in the event we get separated, as has happened before. But I haven't traveled for my job in over 18 months.

My interest was finally pushed over the edge by reading an article by somebody in the Netherlands who bought an AirTag and then mailed it to himself. Yep, that's right. Now, the AirTags only work if you have an iPhone but if you do, they offer some incredible detail into location of the AirTag which the article illustrated really well. The person who wrote the article was able to track the AirTag location from the mailbox where they dropped it, over a round journey of 120 miles as it traveled to a local post office, to a regional center, and then back to the post office and finally out for delivery.


This remarkable ability to track location is the result of the way that AirTags work and how it is different to other gadgets like Tile. Note that I also have my FAA registration as my AirTag name

AirTags use ultra-wideband technology and take advantage of Apple's existing network of devices, which work as crowdsourced beacons to ping each other in order to determine your missing item's location. AirTags do not include a GPS chip like your iPhone. Instead, Apple has used its proprietary U1 chip with ultra-wideband technology to create a peer-to-peer network that taps into the 1.65 billion Apple devices out in the wild to nail down the location of an AirTag.

Now, you can also search for AirTags directly from your phone if they're close enough. The figure here shows where my Aero Scout is.

If you can't locate the tracker, there is an option in the "Find My" app on the iPhone to place the AirTag in Lost Mode and create a custom message to be displayed when your AirTag is found by another user. When they hold the AirTag



near their phone, your message—like contact details—will appear on their device, and the Good Samaritan will hopefully get in touch. This will work on any device that has NFC enabled, meaning Android owners can help return lost AirTags, too but they cannot use them for tracking which exposes a more nefarious use for AirTags.

As soon as the YouTuber dropped the package in the mailbox, he put the AirTag into the 'Lost' mode. What this basically did was to invoke AirTag to send a notification (with its location) every time it encountered an Apple device. Moreover, he ran a custom script on his Mac's Automator to check the AirTag's location and take a screenshot every 2 minutes — to trace its journey. This ability to find its location, if it comes into nearby proximity to any Apple device, makes it a potentially good way to find fly-aways while the local communication can give you the chance to find a plane that is nearby but in brush or long grass. It should work great but I hope I never find out.

[Additional notes from Mark] I also now have a silicon AirTag holder for a dog collar that perfectly slides over the battery [with] Velcro. Nice, nice installation and movable between planes:)

Micah: These updated 2022 stickers have a farther range than the 2021 version they just retired. Range improvement went from 150 to 250 feet.

Mel: Thanks Micah. ohave you used them?

Micah: Yes, I have some that I use when I'm flying in areas with a lot of trees.

It doesn't have to be you that walks by and locates it. If you can't find it and somebody walks by later with the app on their phone. Tile will ping you with the updated location.

Was considering updating to the 250ft Tiles for when I fly in Merrimack or Burlington. Where MCRF has a pond, they have trees.
